Aloe 'Andrea's Orange'

PBR status: Pending.

Origin/breeder: Selective breeding in South Africa.

Potentially invasive: No.

Ornamental features: Very showy plant with neat architectural shape which throws up spears of long lasting tubular shiny orange flowers in winter

Habit & growth: This special small aloe is a tough enough for mass planting in a harsh landscape environment. It flowers young, has a clumping habit and grows to 30cm x 30cm

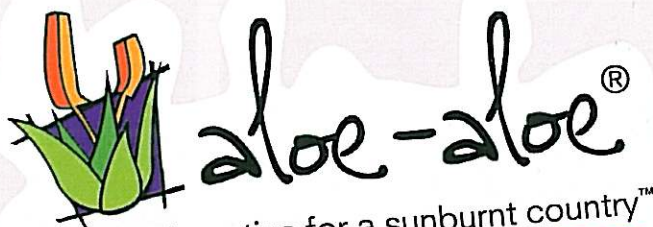
Preferred aspect and soil: Full sun, free draining soil

Frost tolerance: Moderate.

Landscape uses: Tough landscaping plant – copes with drought, rain, heat and cold.

Maintenance: Very low – water sparingly.
