PBR status: Eligible. (To be released in 2010.)

Origin/breeder: Selective breeding program in South Africa.

Potentially invasive: No

Ornamental features: Long blood red flowers appear in winter on this tall aloe with prominent spines.

Habit and growth rate: Large architectural plant (2m x 0.5m) which forms a tall stem from an early age.

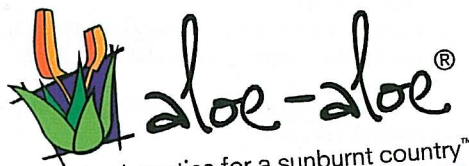
Preferred aspect and soil: Full sun, free draining soil.

Frost Tolerance: Moderate

Landscape uses: Feature plant for landscape use.

Maintenance: Very drought hardy (but tolerant of high rainfall) and very low maintenance.

Aloe Moonglow

PBR status: Protected

Origin/breeder: Selective breeding program in South Africa.

Potentially invasive: No

Ornamental features: Magnificent compact pale yellow flowers appear on this aloe from an early age in mid winter. A mature plant has one of the best flower-to-plant ratios of all aloes.

Habit and growth rate: Medium sized architectural plant which grows to full size (0.8m x 0.5m) within four years.

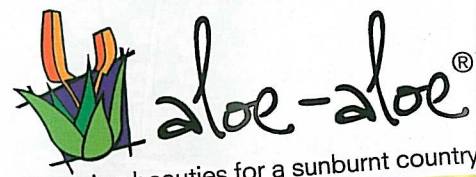
Preferred aspect and soil: Full sun and free draining soil.

Frost Tolerance: Moderate

Landscape uses: Feature plant or planted en-masse

Maintenance: Very drought hardy (but tolerant of high rainfall) and very low maintenance

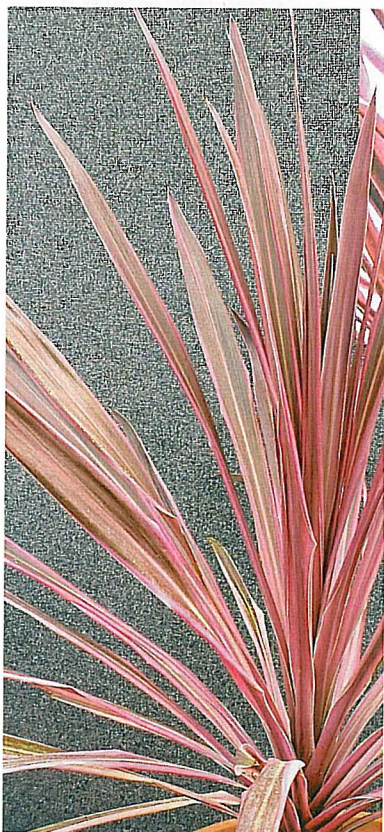


Cordyline Pink Passion

Ornamental features: A very strong clump forming Cordyline with an upright habit. For each Cordyline Pink Passion sold, 20c will be donated to the National Breast Cancer Foundation.

Habit and growth rate: Upright habit, growing to a height of 1.8m x 50cm wide.

PBR status: PBR applied for Origin/breeder: New Zealand

Lic Propagators: Greenhills Propagation Nursery

Ornamental features: Glossy dark chocolate broad leaves up to 1m long that weep. Strongly scented cream coloured flowers that are borne from many panicles above the foliage in many sprays.

Habit and growth rate: Small growing Cordyline with a compact clumping habit growing approx 1m x 1m.

Preferred aspect and soil: Well drained soil, sunny position or partly shaded.

Frost Tolerance: Tolerates light to moderate frosts and dry periods. Landscape uses: Great feature plant for modern borders or great focal plant. Excellent as a tub specimen.
