The Jane McGrath rose is a very attractive old English style floribunda bush rose. Bred for Australian conditions, its lightly scented, pale pink blooms are produced in clusters on slightly arching canes and the blooms will last very well as cut flowers. Hardy in drought conditions

and resistant to black spot, it is an easy-care rose, ideal for mass planting in the garden or growing in a pot. It can be mail-ordered from Treloar Roses or the McGrath Foundation from early June to late August (bare-rooted) or you can ask your local nursery to order one for you.
