PBR status: Applied for  
 Origin/breeder: Peter O'Brienshaw  
 Potentially invasive: No  
 Ornamental features: Pink bell shaped flowers lasting up to six months from autumn to spring.  
 Habit and growth rate: Small shrub to 1m.  
 Preferred aspect and soil: Sunny or part shade. Well-drained soil.  
 Frost tolerance: High.  
 Landscape uses: Park, gardens, median strips.  
 Maintenance: Trim after flowering if formal shape required.



**Correa 'Isabell'**

PBR status: Applied for  
 Origin/breeder: Peter O'Brienshaw  
 Potentially invasive: No  
 Ornamental features: Pale pink bell-shaped flowers and grey foliage. Early winter flowering.  
 Habit and growth rate: Low spreading 0.75m x 1m.  
 Preferred aspect and soil: Sunny or part shade. Well-drained soil.  
 Frost tolerance: High.  
 Landscape uses: Small gardens, pot plant.  
 Maintenance: Trim after flowering if necessary.



**Correa 'Jezebell'**

PBR status: Applied for  
 Origin/breeder: Peter O'Brienshaw  
 Potentially invasive: No  
 Ornamental features: Winter flowering. Masses of red bell-shaped flowers.  
 Habit and growth rate: Upright shrub 1m x 0.75m.  
 Preferred aspect and soil: Sunny or part shade. Well-drained soil.  
 Frost tolerance: High.  
 Landscape uses: Small gardens, pot plant.  
 Maintenance: Trim after flowering if necessary.

**Tomatoberry TM**

PBR status: Not PBR registered  
 Origin/breeder: Bred in Japan  
 Potentially invasive: No  
 Ornamental features: Long trusses of sweet strawberry shaped fruit, glossy red, approx. 2.5cm at shoulder.  
 Habit and growth rate: Approx 1.8m. Early-late fruiting.  
 Preferred aspect and soil: Full sun, well-drained soil. If in pots use a general purpose potting mix.  
 Frost tolerance: Nil.  
 Landscape uses: Attractive in large tubs in courtyards and small gardens, in the veggie patch or to add height and interest to mixed plantings.  
 Maintenance: As for a standard tomato.

**Aloe 'Sirius'**

PBR status: Protected  
 Origin/breeder: Selective breeding in South Africa  
 Potentially invasive: No  
 Ornamental features: Medium architectural plant with strong foliage, showy orange flowers in late winter.  
 Habit and growth rate: Flowers young approx 0.5m high x 0.5m wide.  
 Preferred aspect and soil: Full sun, free-draining soil.  
 Frost tolerance: Light frost only.  
 Landscape uses: Accent plant, in containers, also 'en-masse' as bedding plants, gardens and commercial landscaping.  
 Maintenance: Low maintenance, water sparingly. Fertilised in spring with slow-release fertiliser or organic-rich compost.

**Acmena 'Sunrise'**

PBR status: Protected  
 Origin/breeder: Wirreanda Nursery  
 Potentially invasive: No  
 Ornamental features: New growth flushes with the colours of a spectacular sunrise - pink, apricot and yellow - all year round.  
 Habit and growth rate: Dense habit, moderate growth, best kept at 1-3m.  
 Preferred aspect and soil: Full sun to part shade in moderately drained soil. Will tolerate poorer soils, but will perform better in fertile soils.  
 Frost tolerance: Will tolerate light frosts.  
 Landscape uses: Screen, hedge or as specimen.  
 Maintenance: Low. A regular light trim will encourage new flushes of colour all year round. Feed in spring and autumn with a general-purpose slow-release fertiliser. Mulch well.



**Acmena 'Cherry Surprise'**

PBR status: Protected  
 Origin/breeder: Wirreanda Nursery  
 Potentially invasive: No  
 Ornamental features: New growth flushes with stunning deep cherry red, all year round.  
 Habit and growth rate: Dense habit with moderate growth rate.  
 Preferred aspect and soil: Full sun to part shade in moderately drained soil. Will tolerate poorer soils, but will perform better in fertile soils.  
 Frost tolerance: Will tolerate light frosts.  
 Landscape uses: Screen, hedge or as a specimen.  
 Maintenance: Low. A regular light trim will encourage new flushes of colour all year round. Feed in spring and autumn with a general-purpose slow-release fertiliser. Mulch well.
